A good news story from Tudor and Coombe Hill Ward officers. On Wednesday 6th December both wards responded to an audible alarm on Warren Road. Once the premises was located we carried out a search of the house and found a suspect inside. Both wards worked together to arrest this suspect for Burglary and to preserve evidence.

Over the last month (November 8th – December 8th 2017) the Tudor Ward area has seen a decrease in burglaries. **This is brilliant news in the run up to Christmas!**

The Tudor Ward has had Five (5) Burglary offences this month. This is down by three (3) offences from the previous month.

However we can all do a bit more to try and reduce the number of burglary offences for this month, especially at Christmas time when people leave houses unattended for longer periods.

WHAT THEY TARGET:

- Address's that are left insecure
- · Address's that look empty
- Address's that have poor security features

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Always leave your address locked and secure
- Install Security features (CCTV etc.)
- · Hide valuables in hard to find places
- Keep a log of serial/frame numbers
- Report any suspicious activity (101/999)

RECENT BURGLARY OFFENCES

RICHMOND ROAD

Unknown suspect/s attempted to gain entry through the kitchen window. Tool marks were found on the window frame but entry was not gained into the address.

Your home is only as secure as its weakest point of entry. That's why it's so important to have doors and windows that are as secure as possible. Here is where you'll find lots of helpful advice on how to keep potential burglars out.

Double secure

Simply shutting the door won't prevent burglaries. Double-lock the door every single time you leave the house.

Modern multi-locking and uPVC doors use a system of hooks and latches to secure the door but these only work if you lift up the handle and then remember to turn and remove the key. Remember – lift, lock and remove.
