We have been looking at missing number sentences and we have worked on finding all the subtraction number sentences within one number. We have also looked at the possible addition sums. E.G. $10 + 2 = 12$, $2 + 10 = 12$, $12 - 2 = 10$ and $12 - 10 = 2$

In RE we have looked at the different features of a church e.g. pew, alter, lecture, pulpit, stained glass window and font. The children thoroughly enjoyed seeing these features at St. Luke's Church.
