English

Maths

This week in Maths we have been focusing on subtraction and the understanding that subtraction is the inverse of addition. The children have also used their knowledge of number facts to 20 to solve problems. We have used our understanding of additions to find corresponding subtraction sentences.

Topic

In Science, we explored living plants and used magnifying glasses to see all the different parts of the plant. We labelled the plants and wrote sentences about what a plant needs to survive and why.

In RE we have looked at the story of Noah's Ark. We have discussed how it is a shared story between the Old Testament in the Bible and the Torah. We then sequenced the story.
