## English

For the next two weeks that children will be exploring the book *Lullabyhullabaloo* by *Mick Inkpen*. The children have been immersing themselves in the text by looking at verbs and adding the suffix –ing to them (e.g. squeaking) and looking at onomatopoeia and exploring when you use the suffix –s and –es for making plural nouns. The children have used all these skills within their sentences to describe the characters in the text. The children also had fun re-telling and performing the story by using their voices and instruments.

#### Maths

In Maths this week, the children have been starting to look and understand multiplication. They have been exploring counting in twos, fives and tens. They have been solving problems involving multiplication by calculating the answer using concrete objects and pictorial representations.

#### Topic

In Geography, we are exploring our local area before learning about oceans and continents. This week we have learnt all about the different countries within the United Kingdom. The children have looked at their flags and the capital city of each country, as well as some interesting facts.
