Dear Parent or Carer,

Election of parent governor: proposing candidates

As you may be aware, with effect from 1st September 2018, there will be a vacancy for a parent governor at this school. As the parent/carer of a pupil currently on roll, you have the right to propose a candidate for election or to stand as a candidate yourself. Each parent (father, mother, legal guardian, person having custody) has this right, but you may only propose one candidate.

If you wish to propose a candidate, or stand for election yourself, please take the following action.

1. If nominating another person, obtain permission of the person concerned.
2. Please let me know in writing by no later than **midday on Wednesday 2nd May 2018** the full name, address and telephone number of the candidate proposed, and the full name and class of form of their child/children at the school.
3. Again, by no later than **midday on Wednesday 2nd May 2018**, please arrange for the candidate to let me have, if they so wish, a personal statement in support of their candidacy (the statement should not exceed 100 words).

In the interests of ensuring a fair and equal process canvassing in any form is not permitted.

If only one candidate is proposed, then that candidate will be elected unopposed and all parents will be sent written notice of the name of the new governor, together with their personal statement.

If more than one candidate is proposed, a voting paper, listing the names of all eligible candidates and including any personal statements received by the due date, will be issued to all parents. Details of how the voting process will work will be circulated once the above deadline has passed.

Further details of how a person may be disqualified from being a governor are available at the school and will be issued to all candidates. Unless later disqualified, a parent governor elected now may serve for a four-year term of office.
