In English this week we have continued to look at the Tinga Tinga Tales book: How the Elephant got his trunk. The children have been writing the story out using their own ideas making sure that they are using full stops capital letters and reading their work to check it makes sense. The children finished the week off by doing an independent piece re-telling the whole story. We were really pleased with the work the children produced.

Maths

In math's this week we have been looking at money. The children have learnt the different coins and notes we have in our currency and the value of those coins/notes. The children then moved on to look at adding up different values of money using repeated addition making sure they are using the 'p' for pence in their number sentences. For example 10p + 10p + 10p + 10p = 40p.

Talking Point: How many different ways can you make 25p and 50p? Remember to only use the coins we have in our currency!

Topic

We have been continuing to look at animals and habitats this week. In Science the children chose an animal decided what group it was a part of depending on their features and then wrote some facts about that animal. We had an excellent visit from Zoolab and the children got to handle lots of interesting creatures.

Talking Point: What creatures did you see? What facts can you remember about them?
