Dear Parents/Carers,

One of the highlights this week, was our trip to Thames Young Mariners where the children all took part in a variety of challenging outdoor activities which focused on developing their collaborative skills. We were particularly pleased to see their developing understanding of compass directions and map reading skills; this will be consolidated in our Geography topic this halfterm.

In English, we have launched our work based around the story of *The Egg*, with the children planning the design for their own papier maché egg and learning to use rich descriptive techniques to paint the story in the reader's mind. We have been learning how to use *adverbs*, how to expand simple *noun phrases* using adjective and more specific detail about the noun in a sentence, as well as *prepositions* of both place and time.

By now all the children have had their first couple of French lessons, learning to introduce themselves; a lot of fun was had by all, trying to pronounce the *ou* sound in true gorilla fashion!

Next week, could your child bring a bright, working torch (named) ready for our Science lesson.
