This week in English, we have continued to look at the story of *The Egg*. We have analysed a model text, recapping what we learnt last week, such as adverbs, noun phrases and prepositions. We have now written our first piece of narrative writing in our books including the new grammar skills we have learnt.

In Maths, we have been comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000. We have been using < and > to compare two numbers. We have also been exploring ways of finding 10 and 100 more/less than a given number.

In Geography, we have started our first topic on 'The UK and mapping skills' by identifying the four countries of the United Kingdom and locating their capital cities. Some of us were able to name the seas surrounding the UK.

Finally, the children all experienced and enjoyed their first recorder lesson this week.
