Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you have had an enjoyable half term break. We have been impressed with the Science 'presentations' that the children have compiled during their time with you. We look forward to hearing/reading their findings within the next couple of weeks. In Year 3, we are trialing a new way of teaching Science and the Foundation subjects as a 'block' of sessions rather than the 'once a week' approach. We hope that this will embed the learning at a deeper level for the children and broaden their enthusiasm. We are starting with Geography as we had begun some related teaching before the half-term break. We will then move onto Science, PSHE and RE.

This week in English, we have begun reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. As this is our immersion week, we have explored the start of the text through drama, looking at calligrams as a method of emphasis and have written our own similes to describe the physical appearance of the main character.

In Maths, we have used our understanding of number bonds to extend their application into addition and subtraction (mentally). We have also worked on solving calculations with 'missing' numbers (e.g. ______ - 8 = 375 and ______ + 4 = 402) as well as applying to problems in context.
