English

Mathematics

In Maths this week we have been revising the number bonds. The have revised their number bonds to 10 (pairs of numbers that make 10) and used this to help them work out their number bonds to 20. They children have worked practically with the tens frame, part and part whole model and counters. How many number bonds to 20 can you remember? How does knowing your number bonds to 10 help you with your number bonds to 20? E.g. 8+ 2= 10 18+ 2 = 20

Topic

In Geography this week we have been looking at the weather. We have thought about what sorts of activities we can or can't do in different weathers and the clothes we wear in different weathers.

In ICT this week we have thought about keeping safe when we are on the internet. The children learnt that they should keep their personal information private as well as telling an adult if they come across something that upsets them whilst online.
