This week in English, we have been reading a poem called 'What Happened to Lulu?' By Charles Causley. We have also been learning about what abstract nouns are, and writing a poem on an abstract noun of choice

In Maths, we have continued our learning on division. We have been dividing 2-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers by 1 digit numbers using short division (bus stop method). We have also been checking our answers using the inverse.

Science this week has been about teeth! We have been learning how best to look after our teeth, and why we need to. Each class has set up an experiment involving popular drinks and hard boiled eggs. Children have been making predictions about what they think will happen to the egg shells, and we will observe next week the effect of the drinks.
