It was good to see so many of you at the Parent Consultations this week. We hope that you agree that we have had positive and valuable conversations and that you now have a clear picture of the progress your children have made towards their targets.

In the last week of term, we are planning our Greek Day. This will involve the children dressing as Ancient Greeks for the day (some guidance will be coming home on this, don't worry!) and we are planning some lovely activities as the finale for this topic. We would love to be taking photos of the children on this day to share on the school website, so can you ensure that you have completed the photograph permission letters sent home some time ago, even if you do not wish to grant permission. There are still some in Y5, which are now overdue. Thank you.
