- No sweets or biscuits



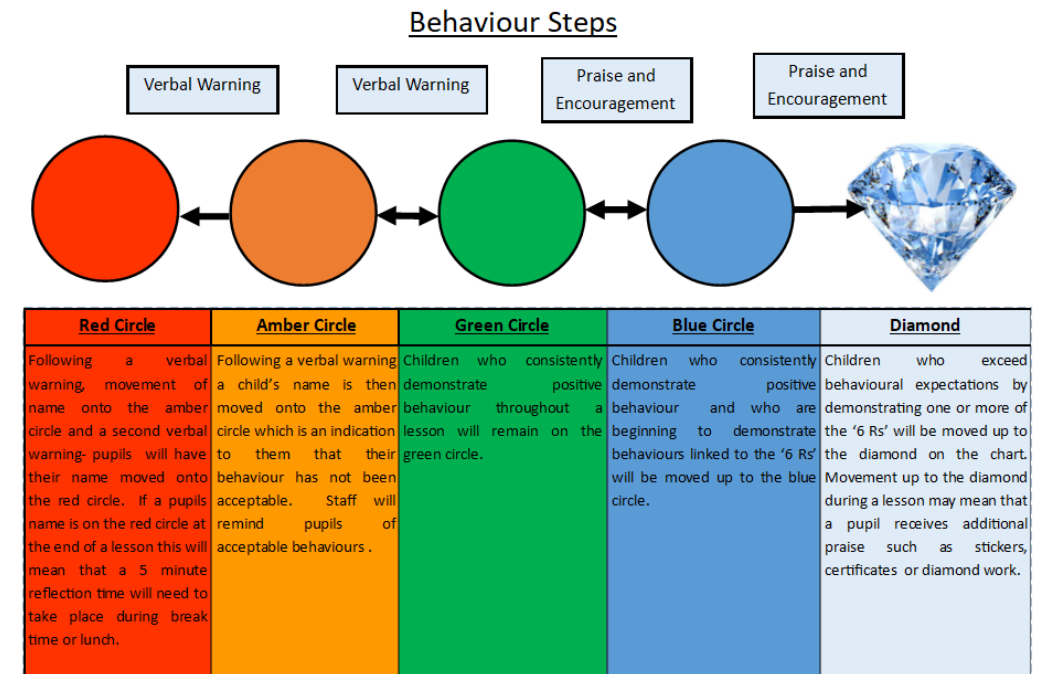
Onsite Code of Conduct

- Speak to a member of staff if you are worried about anything

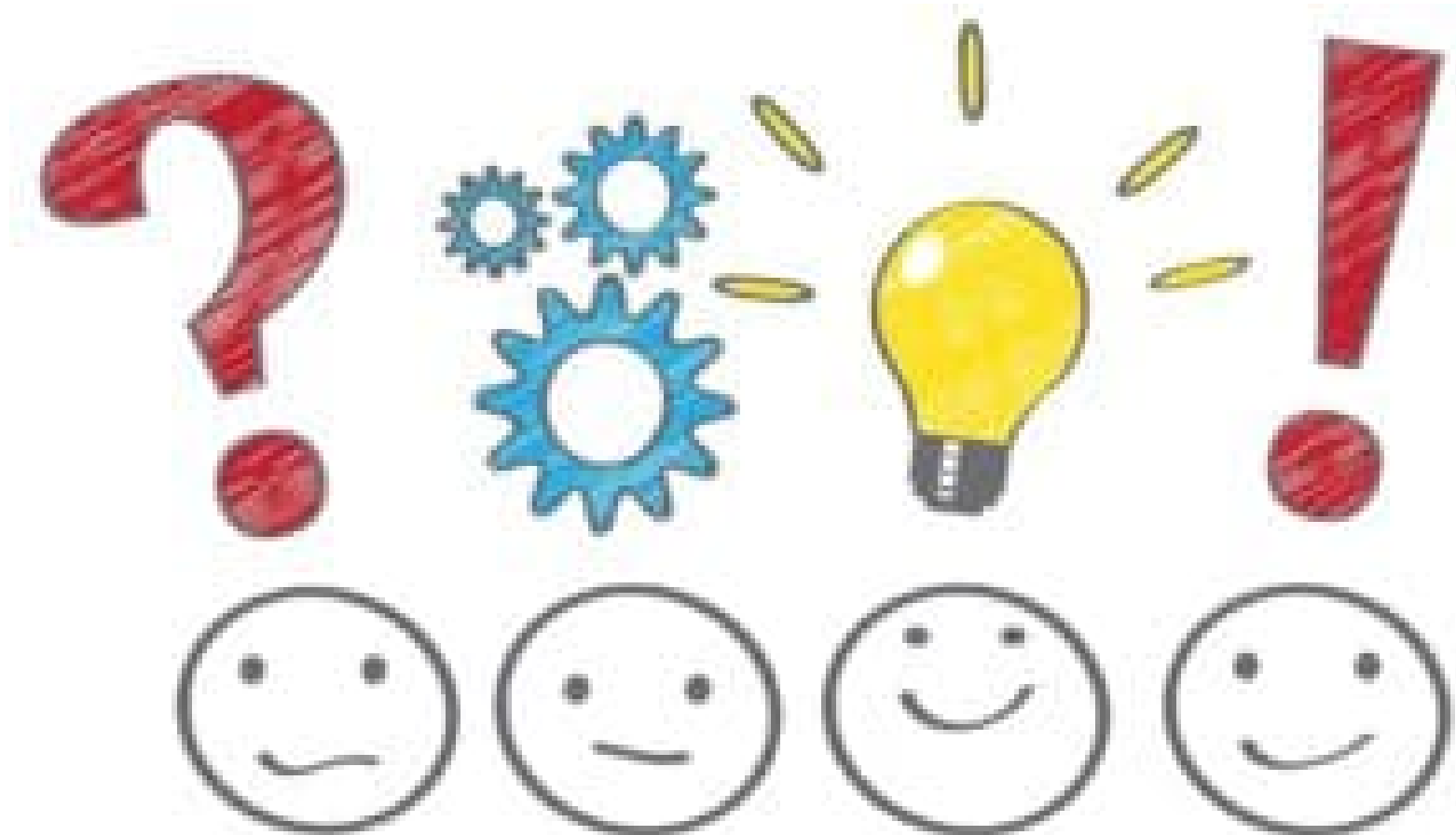


How can you help?
