English

This week, we have concluded our work inspired by The Necklace of Raindrops. Our focus has been on extending the children's vocabulary and using adjectives to describe. We have also been discussing what makes an exciting story opening. The children have produced some wonderful descriptive stories.

Maths

The children have enjoyed revising money including coin recognition and making the same amount with different coins. They have also been using their reasoning skills to solve a range of problems involving number, money, shape and time.

Next week we will be looking at measure and practising reading scales. Please encourage your children to find measuring tools in your homes e.g. weighing scales, measuring jugs, fuel gauges in the car and thermometers etc.

Topic

In History, we learnt about the different factors that contributed to the Great Fire spreading so quickly including the weather conditions and the structure of the buildings. We also compared the city then to London today.

In Science, we looked at range of fruit and vegetables and identified the seeds. We then matched them with the fully grown plants and trees and did some scientific drawings.
