Year 6 are working extremely hard but we have much to look forward to in the Summer Term. To celebrate the end of SATS week, we are going to the Spectrum centre in Guildford to do ice-skating and bowling. We will be travelling by coach on the Friday of SATs week.

As part of our Science work, we have a scientist coming in to talk to the children about evolution. He will share photographs and real finds, including teeth and skeletons. Year 6 really enjoyed this workshop last year.

We are visiting Kew Gardens to look at the variety of plants, flowers and seeds as well as to support our Geography and Science work on biomes and adaptation. We will also have an opportunity to enjoy views from the Treetop Walk.

We will be visiting The National Portrait Gallery to view the art and complete a workshop. Children will learn about portrait drawing and choose their own winner of the BP Portrait Award.

Year 6 will be involved in a transition workshop, which is held at Cornerstone on Canbury Park Road. They will meet with other year 6's in the borough. Each pupil will also receive an 'It's Your Move' book, which is a guide to moving to secondary school. These are donated by local churches.

We have chosen a script for our **Year 6 Production** in July. This promises to be a hugely enjoyable project for the children, providing an opportunity to show case all of the talent in Year 6 this year. There will be a morning and evening performance for Y6 parents on **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July 6pm** and **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 9:30am**.

As part of our outdoor PE we are offering the children the chance to learn water sport skills at Albany Park sailing club. In past years we have tried canoeing, kayaking and dragon boating. The sessions will be longer this year, but for fewer weeks; this worked well last year. The total cost of water sports will change according to the number of children that participate, but will be about £27 for the two sessions.

The Year 6 Disco will be on Thursday 18th July 5:30-7:30pm. We will be compiling a play list over the coming term so please let us know any favourites songs.

The total voluntary contribution requested is £15 (excluding water sports). Payment can be made via Parent Pay or by cash/cheque via the school office (in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, class and trip).

Would you please note that if insufficient, voluntary contributions are raised to fund the trips, they may have to be cancelled. Children in receipt of pupil premium/free school meals do not have to pay.

The children will need packed lunches for the trips to the Spectrum, Kew Gardens, and the National Portrait Gallery. If your child would like a school packed lunch for the trip, then please ensure you book this online via Parent Pay, before the usual lunch deadline and at least 5 working days before the trip day. Alternatively, please send your child in with a packed lunch for the trip. Please note that you should not order a hot lunch on trip days – these will automatically be cancelled by the school and a credit added to your Parent Pay lunches balance if relevant.

Once we know how many children are taking part in water sports we will send out separate consent forms and collect payment. Please indicate on the reply slip whether or not you would like your child to take part in the water sports activities. We will need adults to help on all of the trips, in order for them all to take place. Please indicate on the reply slip if you are able to help out. We thank you for your continued help and support.
