English

In English this week we have been reading the poems from Rumble in the Jungle by Giles Andreae and David Wojtoyca. The children have designed their own front cover and worked collaboratively to act out one of the poems. We were really impressed with what actions they came up with! They have written a riddle about an animal – can they remember the clues the wrote?

Maths

In Maths we have focused on position and direction. The children have been learning quarter, half and full turns and have been doing lots of practical activities linked to this. The children have also describe positions of objects e.g. to the left of, to the right of, below and above. They've located items on a pirate map using directions such as move forward 3, turn right, continue forward for 5 squares.

Topic

In Science this week we continued with our animal topic; the children have learnt about amphibians, mammals, reptiles, fish and birds and sorted them according to their features. The have written facts about an animal, thinking about where it lives and what it likes to eat.
