In Maths, we have been practising number bonds to 20. It is important that all children have a secure understanding of these and also the related subtraction facts. For example: 16 + 4 = 20, 4 + 16 = 20, 20 - 16 = 4 and 20 - 4 = 16. This is known as the inverse.

In English, we have been studying a picture book called Flotsam by David Weisner. The children were encouraged to use their interpreting, and inference skills to study the illustrations in the book and write about what they saw and what might be happening. They are really enjoying this book.
