Cash payments must be made to the school office and a receipt will be provided.

If there are not sufficient funds by Christmas, the Year 6 Christmas Party will be parent-donated food, instead of pizza. The most expensive trip is Guildford Spectrum which will not happen if we do not receive sufficient contributions.

There are also additional opportunities in the Summer Term of Albany Watersports ( $£ 30$ ), Hoodies ( $£ 16$ ) and Yearbooks (£tbc organised by class reps).
