



Year 3

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week in Maths we have continued working on addition and subtraction. We have been working on understanding the concept of exchanging.

For example ...=122 - 8



We have used practical equipment to understand you cannot take 2 ones away from 8 ones. You need to exchange 10 ones for 1 ten. Then you can calculate $12 - 8 = 4$. Therefore $114 = 122 - 8$.

In English, we have continued preparing to write our non-chronological report on dragons. We have been writing complex sentences by using subordinating conjunctions. After half term, we will begin writing a class guide to all our wonderful dragons!

We have had a great first half term in Year 3. The children deserve a well earned break but please continue to read, practise spellings and complete all Mathematics tasks set.
