### **English**

In **English** this week we have started our new book The Everywhere Bear written Julia Donaldson and illustrated Rebecca Cobb. The children have been thinking about emotions and how characters feel during certain parts of the story. The children have then written a thought bubble using lots of lovely emotional language.

**Science:** In science this week started their materials topic. The children have looked at different materials and thought about what adjectives they could use to describe them based on their properties.

In **Art** this week we have looked at sketching in particular we have looked at shading from light to dark. The children drew some fantastic Autumn pictures we were so impressed with what the children produced.
