It has been a busy and rewarding week in Year 3 and we hope that your child feels fully enthused with the new topics which we have been introducing across the curriculum.

In English, the children have been 'deconstructing' a piece of writing to look at how the planning process has been put in place. They have been identifying high quality vocabulary, together with time and place prepositions. This process should then assist them in writing their own paragraphs about the capture of a bird of paradise!

We have continued our topic on multiplication and division with work on bar models as a visual aid to calculation. We have also considered the inverse operation when deciding if a number sentence makes 'sense'.

In both Design & Technology and History, we have been considering where historians find evidence to tell us about life and events in the past. As one of these evidence sources, we have examined cave paintings, talked about the method of creating them, before having a go ourselves in representing Stone Art life through art.

As next week is Arts Week, we are anticipating lots of creative discussion and work to be produced, ready for your annual exhibition.
