We have had a fabulous Arts Week and the children have taken part in a wide variety of creative activities based around shape, pattern and measure inspired by Mondrian and primary colours.

English

In English this week, our independent task was to use our own ideas to write an ending to 'The Bear and the Piano'. Children worked hard to include adverbs, high quality vocabulary and clear punctuation. Next week we will begin to study a new text - Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown.

Maths

This week, we have started a new topic Shape. The children have explored the differences between 2D and 3D shapes. They have also used mathematical language to describe 2D shapes including the number of sides and vertices. Next week we will be focusing on 3D shape, symmetry and pattern.

Topic

Thank you to those of you who provided a sock for our science lesson this week. We worked together in small groups to carry out our investigation, which included making a predication, discussing what makes a fair test and measuring the different socks. We then used weights to 'stretch' the socks and will be discussing our conclusions next week.

Today we enjoyed a visit from Florence Nightingale who helped bring our topic to life. She told us a lot more information about what it was like for her and we used drama to understand more about the conditions and the role of soldiers and nurses in the Crimean War.
