Dear Parents and Carers,

On behalf of the school governors, I would like to welcome you back to this new term. The start of a new year is a good time to update you on the work of Fern Hill's Governing Body over the past twelve months.

#### **Curriculum & Assessment**

Some of you will be aware that in September Ofsted launched its new inspection framework for schools with an increased focus on the 'quality of education'. This represents a significant change to the way in which schools are inspected and our Governing Body has worked closely with the Senior Leadership Team to reflect on the impact of those changes on how governors carry out their role. As a result, we have now assigned a named governor to each subject area - shifting our focus away from individual year groups and looking more holistically at curriculum and assessment across the school. Governors are now involved in the review of subject area action plans, observing how a subject is taught across the school and reporting back to the Governing Body on pupils' progress and new developments in the subject.

## Nursery

Last year we set up a working party to look at ways of building on the success of our Nursery provision to provide a more flexible offering for our families. We were particularly keen to respond to feedback from families who said they would welcome the option for full-time places and wraparound care. We are very pleased to announce that we are now offering extended hours and the option to access Tree Tops for our Nursery children. We hope that these changes will be of assistance to our families and we continue to look at further ways of providing a Nursery that is suited to our families' needs. Do look out for our new Nursery leaflet, soon to be available on the school website.

### **Finance**

Financially our focus remains on cost efficiency and maximising income and we are pleased to report that, as a result of the school's robust financial management, we continue to operate a balanced budget. Unfortunately, not all of the school's equipment and resources that benefit the pupils' learning and development can be provided out of the school budget.
