

THE VISION

The aim of the ADP is to give invited, talented, grass roots players the best possible platform to succeed. By incorporating an in-depth coaching syllabus and by limiting group numbers the ADP aims to replicate an academy environment whilst maintaining the fun & safe elements that inspire the players to play the game.

The Programme

The Advanced Development Programme will consist of the following age groups U6 – U9 with UEFA B coaches assigned to each age group.

Each age group will follow a specific coaching syllabus unique to Platform which works following a 3-part monthly topic. Each month will consist of an in-possession topic, transitional element & out of possession topic.

All sessions will begin to install individuality, creativity, confidence and intelligent decision-making during game situations.

One showcase game will be arranged each month to allow players to put the topic into practice and provide a platform for the players to express themselves.

10 PLATFORM PARENT PRINCIPLES
