Maths

In Maths this week we have finished focusing on place value to 50. We began by finding one more and one less than a number up to 50. We investigated the following statement: "When you find one more of a number only the one digit changes". We have also compared manipulatives and numbers using the inequality signs and finished the week by counting in 2s and 5s.

English:

In literacy this week we have continued with the beautiful story of Lila and the Secret of Rain. The children have thought about the different weathers Lila experiences on top of the mountain before completing an independent write of the story.

Phonics: ear, ere, eer (making the ear sound) and ve at the end of words (e.g. love, give).

Science: In Science this week we have looked at the differences between the seasons Autumn and Winter. The children thought about what clothes, activities, plants and weather they experience in the two seasons.
