In Maths, we have compared mathematical statements, using times tables to reason. We have also touched upon using related facts, transferring our knowledge of e.g. $3 \times 6 = 18$ to $30 \times 6 = 180$ OR $3 \times 60 = 180$, as well as the related division facts.
