In Geography we have used IT to carry out research and produce a fact file on an Amazonian animal. Feel free to quiz your child about what they have found out.

In Art we have developed our sketching skills; we have worked hard to represent different leaf shapes. We recapped on using different tones and textures.

This week's English has seen our guided write on the *Lost Happy Endings*. The children have put a lot of effort into writing an appropriate ending to the story, applying the writing techniques that we have practised in class.

In Maths, we have finished off multiplication by solving worded problems, before moving onto division (2-digit numbers by 1-digit). Please note that the children are not taught *short division* yet but are instead using practical and visual approaches to divide into equal groups. Next week we will be moving on to working with money. Supporting your child with adding different coins would be greatly appreciated. Perhaps they can pay for something and work out the correct change (role-play or real life experience).

To end the week, we also enjoyed watching Elm Class' assembly. Well done, children, great effort and a big thank you to Miss Evans (student teacher) for her support.
