
Weekly News - 2nd October 2020

English

The children have begun reading a new text: 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane'. They have thoroughly enjoyed reading the text and discussing the characters and plot. They worked very hard to use inverted commas in speech.

Maths

We have been exploring 4 digit numbers, representing them in a variety of ways. We have used part-part whole models, place value charts, place value counters and number lines to secure our knowledge of four digit numbers.

Foundation Subjects

In Science we looked at how the River Thames has changed and adapted and has been a habitat to living organisms over the years. In Topic we used atlases to identify different rivers.
