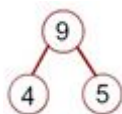
English

In English this week the children have looked at the story Stanley's Stick by John Hegley. The children have imagined what they would do with a stick and what it could become. We were so impressed with what the children thought of! The children have sequenced the story and written some beautiful sentences remembering their full stops and capital letters. We even had some lovely adjectives too!

Phonics: We have looked at the sounds; oy, ir, ue and aw. Our Common Exception Words are: their and old.

Maths

This week the children have been introduced to the part whole model. They have been using it to find the parts related to the whole. The children have used numerals and pictorial representations and successfully split them into two and three parts. They have also thought of some lovely maths stories to represent numbers within 10.



9 is the whole; 4 is a part and 5 is a part.

Foundation Subjects

Science: In Science this week the children have thought about what plants grow in the Secret Garden. We have then used this information to create an improved Secret Garden in **Geography**. We will be creating our 3D improved gardens in next week's geography lesson.
