Our focus this week

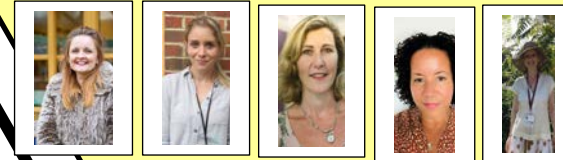
