# **English**

The children completed their recounts of the wordless book Flotsam and it was great to see them using such creative adjectives and similes to describe the journey that the camera took across the ocean to a tropical beach. The children then used these skills to write a recount of their Seaside Journey workshop.

#### Maths

We have continued to focus on addition and subtraction and have been using the part, part whole strategy and practising writing the different calculations (e.g. 13 + 4 = 17, 17 - 13 = 4, 17 = 4 + 13, 4 = 17 - 3) including where the sum or difference is at the start before the = symbol.

# **Foundation Subjects**

In DT we have been focussing on building and completing our fabulous bathing machines. Next week, the children will have an opportunity to show all the knowledge they have gained about the history of seasides by producing a mind map about travel, clothes, entertainment and food in the past. They will then use these to write postcards from a Victorian seaside in the first person.
