# Year 1

#### **English**

In English this week we have started a new story, 'The Lonely Beast' by Chris Judge. The children have explored verbs by thinking about all the things the beast likes to do. We have looked in detail at a picture in the book and discussed how the beast may be feeling at that point in the story. *Talking Point: Can you remember what the beast likes to do?* 

**Phonics -** This week we have looked at the sounds: oa, ew, wh, ph

#### Maths

In maths this week we have focused on the numbers 6-9. We looked at wholes and parts: if a part is 5 and the whole is 10 what will the other part be? We have finished the week by looking at 5 and 5 making 10 and how the numbers 6, 7, 8 and 9 lie on a number line.

#### **Foundation Subjects**

**History**: In history this week we have started our new topic - *Exciting Explorers*. We will be focusing on a new explorer each week. This week we looked at David Attenborough and found out why he was knighted twice! Who do you think we will learn about next week?

**Science**: In science this week we have started to classify animals according to their features. This week we focused on mammals, birds and fish. Can you remember what features a mammal, bird and fish has?
