English

Maths

The children have been finding all the pairs of numbers that make 7 and 8. We used part, part-whole models and bar models to help us work out the different pairs systematically. We read maths stories and completed part-part whole and bar models to represent the information.

Foundation Subjects

History: This week the children went back to 1930 to learn out the next exciting explorer, Amy Johnson. The children discussed why her achievements are admired and they designed their own stamp to honour her. **Talking point**: Can your child tell you why Amy Johnson is famous?

Art: The children looked at patterns and lines found in animal prints and enjoyed experimenting using different mediums such as pastels, paint and charcoal to recreate animal prints.
