

English

This week in English we have completed our spooky paragraphs based on the book, Coraline by Neil Gaiman. The children have been thinking how to use a range of different clauses in their writing. Now that we are in Year 6, it is important to include semicolons - correctly - in our writing. We have been introduced to hyperbole for the first time and it's the absolutely the best technique to use in writing ever!

Maths

This week we started using the compact method for multiplication, two digit by two digit. We will be moving onto three and four digits by two digits. It is super important that the children know their times tables for this skill. Please keep practising at home.

Foundation Subjects

In science, the children were able to carry out their own investigations by thinking of questions about changing components in a simple circuit.
