### **English**

This week, we have worked on developing our understanding of the features of nonfiction writing. The children have matched statements to their correct subheading and have begun to understand the formal voice. We have also continued to develop our vocabulary, delving into the text and picking out precise, descriptive words and phrases to add to our plans for writing next week.

#### Maths

This week, we have been adding and subtracting multiples of ten and ones to 3 digit numbers using a variety of strategies to bridge across 100. We have used our bonds to ten and 100, number lines and jottings. It is important that the children choose the strategy that they prefer when solving these types of calculations and be able to reason why they think their strategy is more efficient than another.

## **Foundation Subjects**

In Geography, we have now all learnt to locate many of London's green spaces using simple coordinates, creating a map. We have also investigated the effects of pollution on our own green spaces by rubbing a cotton bud on leaves near the road and far away from it.
