English

Maths

This week has all been about division! We revised the bus stop for short division - three or four digit numbers by one digit - before moving on to long division - three or four digit numbers by a two digit number. This was a little tricky for some children.

Foundation Subjects

In geography, we examined two photos of the same place in Kingston (the market square) but from different times and looked for changes and similarities. Did you know that cars used to be able to drive right through? We rounded up our science topic on electricity by writing news reports about the need for renewable energy.
