English

We explored and practised using persuasive language to discuss whether Mr Fox is a hero or a villain.

Maths

In maths this week we have been partitioning 2 digit numbers into different combinations of tens and ones. We have also been learning about what happens when you add or subtract 10 from a 2 digit number. We have learnt that our ones digit stays the same and it is only the tens digit that changes.

Foundation Subjects

In science we found out about different microhabitats in Britain and some of the animals there and the children had an opportunity to explore the Forest Fun area. They found a selection of minibeasts including woodlice, spiders, worms, pond skaters and centipedes. In geography, the children completed their fantastic maps of Isabella Plantation.
