Teddy Tennis

We are very lucky to have 'Teddy Tennis' with us this half term. The children will have a half hour session each Friday to learn basic tennis skills. Please ensure your child comes in wearing extra comfy shoes on a Friday :)

Phonics

Oral blending and segmenting are skills that children need to be able to do before picking up a book and reading it. We have started playing games to help to build up this skill. We have been playing 'Simon Says.'

Eg. Teacher says, 'Simon says put your finger on your h-ea-d' or 'Simon says put your finger on your 'f-oo-t.' Foot and head are sounded out and the children need to be able to hear what the word is.

Maths

We have had a go at using our fingers to represent a number. The children have been partitioning numbers in different ways using their fingers, for example by holding up two fingers on one hand and three fingers on the other hand to make 5.
