History: In history we have continued to look at castles, We looked at all the different people who lived in a castle and their roles. The children had great fun acting out the different roles for their partner to guess.

Science: In science this week we have learnt about materials which are opaque, translucent, transparent. The children predicted and investigated which materials would be suitable for a King's curtains in a castle.
