English

Maths

This week, children have been learning about 'area'. We have counted squares and used our knowledge of multiplication to work out the area of rectilinear shapes.

Foundation Subjects

In History, we have been learning about Anglo Saxon homes and burial sites. In Art, we printed a 'zoomed in' design of an Anglo Saxon cross using polystyrene and paint. They turned out great! Children were encouraged to think about the process of printing and how to improve their work, e.g. thinking about how much paint they use.
