English

This week we concluded work on our new text 'One Day on our Blue Planet... in the Outback' by Ella Bailey. The children thought about Sir David Attenborough's style of documentary and wrote their own version of the text! They remembered to include facts as well as descriptive language.

Phonics: In phonics this week we have recapped tricky words - by, my, come, some, could. We have also looked at the six alternative "ee" spellings.

Maths

This week we have looked at multiples of 10. We have represented numbers using numerals, words and pictures and created some wonderful posters showing our understanding. We have also looked at representing multiples of ten in repeated addition number sentences.

Foundation Subjects

Art: This week, the children finished creating their A3 collage of one of the Australian aerial photographs using a range of materials. They then used a variety of tools such as tooth-picks, corks, straws to practise their mark making skills. The results are fantastic and the children were very pleased with their creations!

Geography: Following on from last week's lesson, where the children created a small world of an Australian locality, the children drew 2D maps. They thought about which human and physical features they included and then wrote a key with symbols.
