

Parent Council Work Summary 2020/21

- The Parent Council continued during the COVID-19 pandemic, despite the many challenges of engaging with parents, to seek feedback and meet remotely, with fewer meetings than normal due to lockdowns. The Council was a particularly important channel of communication between parents and school at a time when parents were so distanced from school life and matters.
- The Council helped to communicate the new behaviour system to parents and gathered parents' feedback on how they felt behaviour is managed at school. Findings could not be fully implemented during the pandemic, but there will be a dedicated session on behaviour at the Curriculum Evening, planned for 1st December 2021.
- Council members acted as a consultation group, giving views and feedback on the school's revised Relationships and Sex Education policy.
- The Council gathered feedback from parents on lessons learnt during periods of school closure and remote learning and as a result the new Home Learning area of Google Classroom has been created, with the aim of streamlining the various different communication channels and creating a single repository of home learning resources, accessible to parents and children at any time.
